



AV400 Vein Viewing System

The AccuVein AV400 digitally locates veins for medical procedures. It is non-contact and portable, weighing only 275g (9.7 ounces) and can be held at any angle. Simply point the device at an area of the skin and click to see the peripheral veins beneath.



AV300 Vein Viewing System

The AccuVein AV300 is an analog tool for locating veins. It is non-contact and portable, weighing only 275g (9.7 ounces) and must be held perpendicular to the direction of the vein.

Both the AV400 and AV300 systems include a rechargeable battery which is already installed, a charging cradle which keeps your device charged and ready to use, as well as a universal power supply and multinational adapters.



Wheeled Hands-Free Stand

For the medical professional in a hospital, doctor's office or blood donation center, this hands-free accessory can be wheeled over to the bedside or chair. Just place the device in the cup, which has a door that opens and closes with a light pinch of your fingers, and your hands are free to perform the venipuncture procedure!
